In accordance with the Governor's Office Management Directive 205.36, issued November 27, 2002 (regarding recent amendments to the Right to Know Law, 65 P.S. §66.1-66.9), requests for access to public records may be filed with the Right to Know Official identified as follows:

- Liverpool Borough will only accept requests for records in written form on the Standard Right-to-Know form provided by Liverpool Borough or available on the Open Records web site <a href="www.openrecords.state.pa.us">www.openrecords.state.pa.us</a>
   Requests shall not be accepted through the use of telephone.
- Requests must be made between the normal business hours of 5:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m., Monday evenings. Requests made by mail will be date stamped by the following business day.
- Fees incurred will be paid at the time of receipt of the documents requested.
- Fees for the requests are as follow:
  - 1. Copy fee .25 cents per page.
  - 2. Certification of a Record \$1 per record, not per page. (This fee does not include notarization)
  - 3. Specialized Documents such as blue prints, color copies, nonstandard sized documents will be billed at the actual cost to Liverpool Borough.
  - 4. Electronic fees will be billed at the actual cost to the Liverpool Borough.
  - 5. Postage fees will be billed at the actual cost to Liverpool Borough.
  - 6. Prepayment may be required if the fees for the requested documents are estimated to exceed \$100.

- Inspection of records that contain both public and non-public information will be redacted of the non-public information.
- In accordance with the Right-to-Know law, all requests for documents will be responded to within 5 business days in the form of the document(s) requested or the denial and explanation of denial or a request for an extension of time with an explanation of the circumstances of the request.
- Exceptions to a decision by the Borough of Liverpool to deny access to records may be filed with the Right to Know Law Exceptions Official identified as follows:
